General Baptism Information

Thank you for your inquiry about Baptism for your child. In preparation please do the following:

1. Attend a **Baptism Preparation Class** (parents and godparents must be present). Forward the following paperwork for **each child** to be baptized **prior** to the Baptism Prep class:
 - a. A completed **Baptismal Registration Form** (attached)
 - b. A copy of your child's **birth certificate**
2. **You must call the office to pre-register for the class. The paperwork must be completed before attending.**

In your choice of Godparents, the Church asks for **two baptized, Confirmed, and practicing Catholics** to serve as Godparents. If two suitable Catholics cannot be found, at least one of the Godparents must be a Confirmed, practicing Catholic. (A baptized but not-yet-Confirmed Catholic cannot serve as Godparent until they are confirmed.) A baptized non-Catholic Christian (e.g., Protestant) could serve as a *Christian Witness* rather than as a Godparent. Please understand that the *Christian Witness* status only applies to non-Catholics; it cannot be applied to Catholics; see the document "Guidelines for Sponsors."

It is **your responsibility** to forward the required paperwork. To alleviate undue stress at the last minute, don't delay: **please submit the needed information sooner** than later. Forward the required paperwork to:

General Baptism Information

So that all is in order as we begin our pastoral relationship with you and your family, if you are not currently a registered parishioner at one of our parishes, we ask you to call the Parish Office to make an appointment to register prior to the baptism. If you are a parishioner from another parish, we require a letter from your Pastor giving you permission to have your child baptized at our parish.

Lastly, **once all the paperwork has been received**, you will be contacted to confirm the schedule. Please understand that incomplete paperwork or absence from the Baptism Prep Class may necessitate the baptism to be rescheduled.

There is a limit of 6 children for Baptism on any given date, and they are scheduled on a first come, first served basis. For a list of classes and rites for each parish, see the link on the Baptism page.
